



Offenses sometimes take a few games to starting clicking. After scoring 21 points or less in the previous three games, the Nevada offense has scored at least 35 points in their last three contests. This time it was against Utah State on their way to a 35-32 victory. Right guard John Bender (Cochrane, AB) and the Wildcats offense racked up 502 total yards, 313 yards on the ground.

North Dakota lost at home to the undefeated Sioux Falls 28-13. Fighting Sioux receiver Ismael Bamba (Montreal, QC) continues on a solid year grabbing three passes for 73 yards. Linebacker Curtis Dublanko (Thorsby AB) led the team with seven tackles. Brett Cameron (Winnipeg, MB) punted twice for 82 yards, one downed inside the 20.

Two Canadian defensive ends started in Buffalo's 21-17 comeback win over Akron. Bulls Bruno Lapointe (Lennoxville, QC) contributed four tackles in the contest. Zips Hasan Hazime (Pickering, ON) finished with six tackles, a forced fumble, and a sack.

Central Michigan pushed their winning streak to six with a 34-23 victory over Western Michigan in the battle for the Victory Cannon. Chippewas safety Eric Fraser (Burnaby, BC) gathered three tackles. Fellow teammate receiver Kito Poblah (Montreal, QC) hauled in two passes for 31 yards.

Connecticut ran over Louisville to the tune of 208 rushing yards in a 38-25 win. Center Muhammad Petrus (St. Laurent, QC) and defensive end Jesse Joseph (Laval, QC) both started for the Huskies. The freshman Joseph collected three tackles in the match. Tight end John Delahunt (Ottawa, ON) saw limited action.

New Hampshire suffered their first loss of the season to Massachusetts. The Wildcats held a 17-10 lead in the fourth quarter, but the Minutemen took over from there winning 23-17. Wildcats corner Ryan Hinds (Toronto, ON) amassed six tackles and broke up a pass.

California University head coach John Luckhardt won his 200<sup>th</sup> game in a 38-14 triumph over Edinboro. Vulcans offensive tackle Jack Range (Ottawa, ON) helped by paving the way for 268 rushing yards.

Georgetown suffered a home loss 31-14 to Colgate. Hoyas starting running back Charlie Houghton (Toronto, ON) chipped in 123 yards on five kick returns, 10 yards on three carries, and 19 yards on one catch.

Harvard receiver Marco Iannuzzi (Calgary, AB) continues to be a weapon for the Crimson supplying four catches for 37 yards and a touchdown. The junior had 115 yards off five kick returns and 24 yards from two punt returns.

Northeastern State loses to Southwest Baptist, 42-34. Riverhawks defensive back Troy Adams (Toronto, ON) gathered up four tackles and returned a first quarter interception for a touchdown.

Quarterback Myles Gibbon (Montreal, QC) kept Southern Arkansas undefeated in a 41-7 triumph over Louisburg. The six-foot-three freshman completed six of nine passes for 89 yards and a touchdown.

On Thursday, Howard University took a 14-7 loss to Morgan State. Bison linebacker Jean-Mary Patrick made two tackles against the Bears.

Wofford Ameet Pall had three tackles and a sack in a 44-34 loss to Appalachian State.

Adrian loses 17-16 to Albion after giving up a late touchdown. Bulldogs punter Kevin Allaer punted twice for a total of 61 yards, downing one inside the 20.
