



Ball hawks have a nose for the football, always finding a way to take it away from the opponent. New Hampshire corner Ryan Hinds (Toronto, ON) persists to wreak havoc on offenses adding another interception to his collection in an 18-10 victory over Hofstra. The North Toronto alum also chipped in four tackles to hold the Pride offense under 300 total yards.

Nevada rolled over Idaho for their fourth straight win, 70-45. Guard John Bender (Cochrane, AB) and the Wildcats offense rushed for 484 yards against the nation's 14th ranked rush defense. Their eight rushing touchdowns tied a team record set in 1981 against Central Arkansas.

Washington State lost their contest 49-17 to California despite 385 passing yards. Joe Epele (Vancouver, BC) and the Cougar offensive line did not allow a sack. Receiver Johnny Forzani (Calgary, AB) reeled in four passes for 116 yards and a touchdown. The junior also made one special teams tackle.

Central Michigan improved to 7-1 on the season with a 24-10 win over Bowling Green. Chippewas safety Eric Fraser (Burnaby, BC) finished with five tackles, holding the Falcons to 20 rushing yards. Kito Poblah (Montreal, QC) plucked four passes for 36 yards in the match.

North Dakota failed to muster much against Southern Utah losing 35-10. Fighting Sioux linebacker Curtis Dublanko (Thorsby, AB) recorded four tackles, a sack, and two quarterback hurries. Receiver Ismael Bamba (Montreal, QC) was held without a catch, but had one rush for three yards. Brett Cameron (Winnipeg, MB) punted three times totaling 138 yards, downing two punts inside the twenty.

Weber State did not trail once in their contest with Northern Colorado to win 28-20. Wildcats tight end Tyrell Francisco (Kelowna, BC) caught two passes for 8 yards and a touchdown.

Missouri S&T squeaked out a victory in a 39-37 shootout with the University of St. Francis (Indiana). Halfback Jerome Miller (Toronto, ON) churned out 33 yards from ten carries.

Harvard shut down Princeton at home 37-3. Wideout Marco Iannuzzi (Calgary, AB) hauled in three passes for 36 yards, and rushed for 10 yards on two carries.

Northeastern State Troy Adams (Toronto, ON) racked up ten tackles in a 45-35 loss to Southeastern Oklahoma.

Akron defensive lineman Hasan Hazime (Pickering, ON) contributed four tackles, a sack, and one quarterback hurry in a 28-14 loss to Syracuse.

California University offensive lineman Jack Range (Ottawa, ON) paved the way for 188 rushing yards in a 44-7 blowout against Slippery Rock.

Utah State linebacker Connor Williams (Konata, ON) recovered a fumble in a 23-20 triumph over Louisiana Tech.

In a 35-26 victory over Western Carolina, Wofford defensive end Ameet Pall (Montreal, QC) had three tackles in the game.

Wagner College starting linebacker Carl-Olivier Prime (Quebec, CA) gathered three tackles in a 49-28 win over Sacred Heart.

Duke sneaked past Maryland for a 17-14 win. Blue Devils corner Chris Rwabukamba (Windsor, ON) collected five tackles.

Buffalo defensive lineman Bruno Lapointe (Lennoxville, QC) made two tackles and recorded a quarterback hurry in a disappointing 34-31 overtime loss to Western Michigan.

Adrian engaged in a defensive battle with Hope, coming out on top 7-6. Bulldogs punter Kevin Allaer (Wallaceburg, ON) had 333 yards off 10 punts - downing three inside the 20.

Howard University linebacker Jean-Mary Patrick (Montreal, QC) accumulated two tackles in a 30-19 loss to North Carolina A&T.

Idaho linebacker Nic Edgson (West Vancouver, BC) came up with two tackles in a 40-12 defeat to Northern Arizona.

Michigan defensive tackle Renaldo Sagesse (Montreal, QC) amassed two tackles in a 35-10 loss to Penn State.

Ohio Wesleyan defensive back Kyle Karczynski (Caledonia, ON) had a tackle in a 26-14 loss to Washington (Montana).

Michael Atkinson (Windsor, ON) made one tackle in the seventh ranked Boise State 54-9 win over Hawaii.
