



## **FINAL SELECTION CAMP – NATIONAL JUNIOR U20**

Sixty top U20 football players from across the country from British Columbia to New Brunswick took to a slick field and under cloudy and shower laden skies to participate, at the University of Western Ontario, in the final Canadian selection camp for the inaugural International Federation of American Football (IFAF) Junior World Championship this past Wednesday, June 17.

The Junior World Championship will be held from June 27<sup>th</sup> to July 5<sup>th</sup> in Canton, Ohio.

The final roster of 45 players will be selected this Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup> and leave for Canton on June 25<sup>th</sup>.

There are eight countries that will participate in the championship along with Canada including New Zealand, Mexico, Japan, France, Sweden, Germany and the United States.

Canada is seeded number #1 based on previous junior international play and Canada's opening game is with New Zealand.
